***What Works: Tools, Evidence and Pathways for Gender-Transformative Change***

What does it actually take to support women farmers in a truly gender-transformative way? As part of the *International Year of the Woman Farmer*, this webinar moves beyond visibility and commitments to focus on what implementation requires in practice. Drawing on GIZ's experience in implementing programmes in agriculture and food systems, it highlights three recurring challenges in gender-transformative practice: **building capacity**, **translating concepts into practice**, and **demonstrating change**.

The session introduces complementary resources developed and consolidated through GIZ's FemHub that respond directly to these challenges, including:

- a practice-oriented e-learning developed with a global community of practitioners
- a toolbox of gender-responsive and gender-transformative approaches
- insights on how to better understand and measure impact

Through short inputs, practitioner reflections, and interactive exchanges, participants will gain concrete ideas and tools to strengthen their own work and to move from intention to implementation in supporting women farmers.
